The End of Napoleon's Rule • Napoleon captured and exiled in 1814, escapes in 1815, attempts a "comeback" and loses before he is finally (permanently) exiled until his death of cancer in 1821 • The Napoleonic Wars did not provide any lasting territorial gains for France • The Napoleonic Code & some government reforms proved lasting.
